Secretary:

Jen Chomicki: Read the April 2021 Minutes. Motion was made to approve the minutes. All approved.

Treasurer Report:

Heather Johnson: Continue to be in really good shape. Thanks to everyone for submitting their receipts. Have a few teacher support fund checks to get out this week. No problems or concerns. There are some line items that have not been put in. Titlers bill for tshirts grade k-6 has been paid. Spiritwear check has been received but after May 1st so not showing on this document. Teachers can submit receipts up to \$100 for items. Sheeba Miller sent a thank you note for the supplies.

Principal's Reports:

Mr. Kostiewicz are a go for field day at Centennial and will have it at the school versus MAC. 6th graders will have an opportunity to be outside with their yearbooks and t-shirts and Mr. Kostiewicz will try to get a DJ. Offering DARE graduation for 5th grade students. Restrictions are being lifted after May 31st so we will be inviting 2 parents per child to come to building for graduation. 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Teacher Liason:

MAE are going to do a field trip and it is teacher lead on their own individual grade days, split up on 3 days. Mrs. Shine stated she received a ton of emails from teachers thanking PTO for the luncheon and gift cards and all of PTO support. Dayle Ferguson reminded there is a virtual meeting tomorrow one more time and then likely go back to in-person meetings. Mrs. Ferguson not sure if they will be also streaming the meetings but Mrs. Shine stated a lot of parents have requested that streaming continues. Dayle stated they will be adopting a new tentative budget with a 30 day comment period.

Talent Show:

Spiritwear:

Used Sports Locker for 6 years but new company called Played to Wear has presented really well with different items and ideas and it's a local company. Really liked that they can bring products on site and make as they go so we don't have to pay for items ahead of time and drag around. Will have a lot more choices for parents. They will also ship to home. They didn't state we needed to sign a contract for any time period.

Yearbook:

Stephanie Titas says all 3 schools yearbooks are going out on 21st. Has about 100 leftover to sell and will wait for the following week to sell the extras and leave to the principals on how to handle. Rebecca states PC has only about 20-25 extra. Only 1 family who has called for one so far.
